

## Regarding discrimination and insulting treatment

Campus Nyköping disclaims all forms of discrimination and insulting treatment. Everyone at school has the right to be treated as an individual based on their own conditions, and on the same terms. If situations of discrimination or insulting treatment occur, the school should always act.

Adult education should be a safe and secure place where students and staff will evolve and feel safe. No one, neither student nor staff, shall ever be exposed to discrimination or insulting treatment and everyone should know who to turn to if it were to happen.

Everyone studying or working at Campus Nyköping should know and have access to *the action plan against discrimination and insulting treatment*, which describes routines for preventive work against discrimination and insulting treatment, as well as routines for how to deal with suspected discrimination or insulting treatment.

All action plans for Campus Nyköping, including *the plan against discrimination and insulting treatment* are available to students in the Moodle learning platform as well as at the information desk in Campus Nyköping.

If you, as a student, experience discrimination, insulting treatment or insecurity, you should immediately contact your teacher or your principal.
